





All Non-Healthcare Outbreaks* by Onset Date or Week Opened and Setting February 16, 2020 – May 8, 2021



^{**}Some first responder outbreaks were entered retroactively; the onset dates for these are still being refined.




Total Doses Administered	9,924,916


















Building Vaccine Confidence

Framework for Reopening: Workplaces

Workplaces remain under Cal/OSHA standards

- Distancing and masking for all employees
- Proposed modifications could be voted on Thursday



Framework for Reopening: Masks

Masks are required regardless of vaccination status:

- Public transit/transportation hubs
- Indoor K-12 schools, childcare and other youth settings
- Healthcare settings, including long-term care facilities
- Correctional facilities and detention centers
- Shelters (homeless, emergency, cooling)



Framework for Reopening: Masks

Unvaccinated people (including children 2-12) are required to wear a mask in indoor public settings:

- Retail
- Restaurants
- Theatres
- Family entertainment centers
- Meetings
- State and local government offices serving the public

Everyone can unmask outdoors

except unvaccinated people attending large outdoor events

Everyone has a right to wear a mask; a person may not be prevented from wearing a mask as a condition of participation/entry into a business



Three Things We Can All Promote

- 1. Get Vaccines to LA County Residents Using Mobile Teams/Trusted Providers
- 2. Masking For Unvaccinated People





3. If You Have Symptoms: Get tested. Stay home. Work with contact tracers.
